Weholite for Tumalo TFC Phase I

The Tumalo Irrigation District (TID) is located in Bend, Oregon and its mission is to manage their available resources to meet the present and future water needs of its service area. This is done by providing a reliable supply of irrigation water in an environmentally and economically responsible manner in an atmosphere of courtesy, integrity and quality of service.

Over the past several years, the TID has installed large diameter Weholite recognizing that this piping system offers superior flow characteristics, anti abrasion properties, a leak free joint and it has very low maintenance costs.

TFC Phase I of the TID's piping network was upgraded with the installation 2,600 feet of 90"RSC160 Weholite and six (6) mitered elbows, a man way access chamber and three (3) turn-outs to allow water to be diverted to TID customers.

The installation of the Weholite started in March 2008 and concluded the following month.
