The City of Shafter, California began installation of 10,700 feet of 30" Weholite in June of 1999. The project involved installing an outfall line from the City's primary waste water treatment facility to a secondary treatment facility located two miles away. In a unique fashion, the City of Shafter designed the project in-house and installed the pipeline with City construction crews. Weholite was selected as the most economical after the city considered vitrified clay and open-profile HDPE pipe. KWH Pipe (California) Corp. received the contract to produce the pipe in January of 1999.
